Purpose:

This policy provides guidance regarding acceptable and unacceptable behaviors to ensure the comfort and safety of all users and staff of the Peace River Municipal Library.

1. Rules

- 1.1. Use library materials, spaces, and resources with care and as intended.
- 1.2. Upper and lower body clothing and footwear must be worn.
- 1.3. Keep noise to a modest indoor level.
- 1.4. Refrain from eating or drinking at the public computer stations.
- 1.5. Attend to your belongings.
 - 1.5.1. The library is not responsible for unattended belongings left on the property.
- 1.6. Follow the following library bylaws:
 - "3.3 No person using the building or grounds shall:
 - 3.3.1. Cause unnecessary disturbance or distress to other library users or staff and/or violate Library Board policy.
 - 3.3.2. Remove any library item from the library unless the item has been properly checked out in accordance with the procedures established for checking out library items.
 - 3.3.3. Enter or remain in the library building except during those periods designated as open for public use, or with prior arrangement for after-hours use according to Board Policy.
 - 3.3.4. Solicit other library users and staff for personal, commercial, religious, or political purposes.
 - 3.3.5. Bring any animal, other than a service animal, into the building.
 - 3.3.6. Bring a wheeled vehicle or conveyance, other than a wheelchair or walker, or baby carriage/stroller, into the building."
 - "3.5. All persons using the library shall comply with applicable public health regulations."

2. Unacceptable Behavior

In addition to the above, the following are not permitted on Library property:

- 2.1. Sleeping.
- 2.2. Noise-producing activity that disturbs others.
- 2.3. Fighting, running, or roughhousing.
- 2.4. Monopolizing library equipment, materials, or facilities.
- 2.5. Sexual activity of any kind, sexual harassment, or indecent exposure.
- 2.6. Consumption, possession, or being under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- 2.7. Smoking or vaping inside the library or within 5 meters of entrances.
- 2.8. Abusive language, harassment, carrying of weapons, or violence.
- 2.9. Other behaviors that a reasonable person would find unreasonable.

3. Violations

When this policy is violated, the library may (per bylaw 3.4):

- 3.1. Inform the person of how they violated policy and provide an opportunity for better behavior.
- 3.2. Ask the patron to leave the premises for the day.
- 3.3. Ban the patron from library premises for a period of time, at the discretion of the Library Director or designate.
 - 3.3.1. When a patron is banned a letter will be issued to the person informing them why and for how long they are not allowed to enter the library.
 - 3.3.2. Any violation of such bans will be treated as trespass and RCMP may be called.
- 3.4. Pursue civil or criminal charges as appropriate.
