Occupancy will be limited to 10 patrons to maintain social distancing. Please follow signs and designated floor markings.



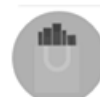
LIBRARY HOLDS ENCOURAGED

We encourage our patrons to place material holds through TRAC at www.tracpac.ab.ca to allow for quick and convenient pickups.



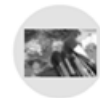
LIMITED COMPUTER USE

Are you getting tired of reading the same books to your littles over and over again? Are you nervous to come to the library and spend time looking through the shelves? We have something new for you!

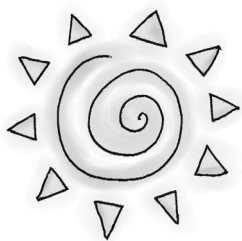

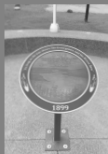

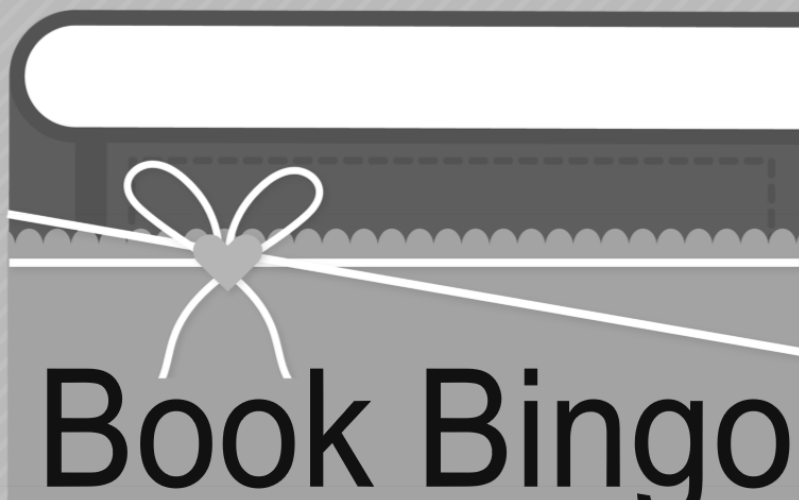

Overdue and other fines:

- DVDs/CDs—50¢/day
- All other material—35¢/day
- A/V material returned in book drop—\$2 (temporarily suspended)
- Lost and damaged items—

- ⇒ Government issued ID is required and proof of address.
- ⇒ Card fees may be waived at the discretion of the Library Director or designate; proof of financial hardship may be required.
