We currently have two computers available for public. Patrons may book one 90-minute session per day. If you require more time please call ahead.

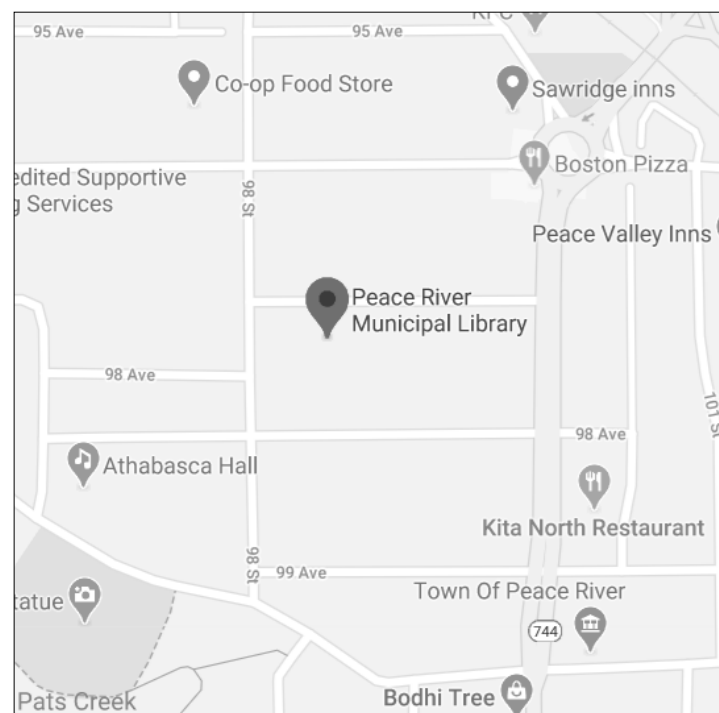
You do not need to have a library card to use the computers.

According to the new Pathways program introduced by the provincial government, the library can expect to be allowed to reopen towards the end of March IF the number of COVID-19 hospitalizations are under 300. In the meantime, contactless service will continue to be offered through Grab & Go and e-resources.

Interlibrary loans are available and can be requested through TRACpac or by calling or emailing the library. Items are still being isolated when they arrive at the library so it can still take extra time for your items to be available for you to pick up. Remember that when you get the automated notification that you have holds ready for pick up, you need to call the library to arrange a Grab & Go appointment.
