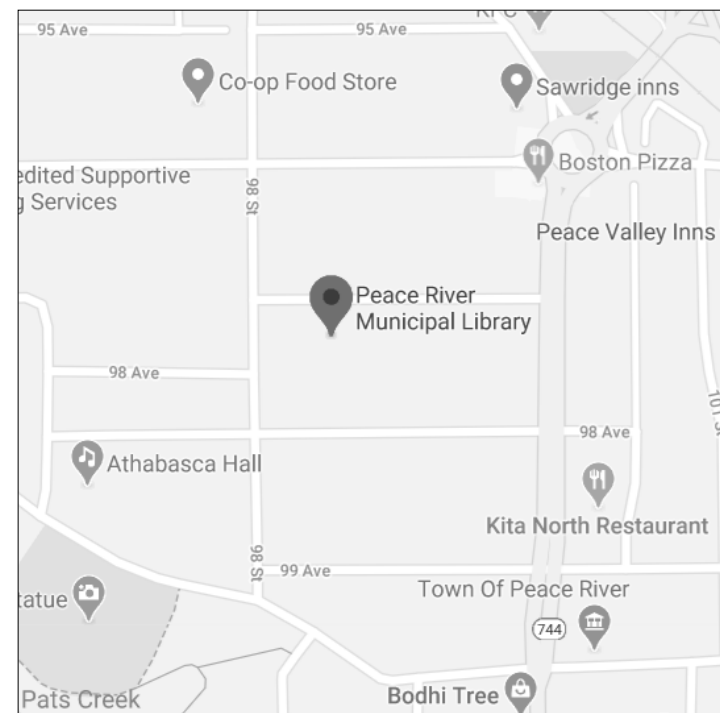
Library cards must be renewed annually.
